


How to use Blackboard Collaborate for Video Conferencing - Students


You will need to use Microsoft Edge, Firefox or Safari to access the Blackboard Collaborate session.

1. Your Teacher or Guidance Officer will book in a time to conduct an online conference with you. They will email you a link or inform you how to access the conference.
2. At the scheduled time, copy the link to one of the supported browsers, listed above.
3. Click on **Join Room**. 
4. If you have not used Blackboard Collaborate previously, it will ask you to download the program. Click **Open** or **Run**. This should take no more than 5 minutes depending on your internet speed.

5. **Blackboard Collaborate** should automatically open.



6. Once inside the platform, click the **Talk** and **Video** buttons to enable both functions.



7. You should be able to hear and see your teacher.
