WHAT IS THE IB DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

The IB Diploma Programme is designed as an academically challenging and balanced programme of education with final examinations that prepares students, generally aged 16 to 19, for success at university and life beyond. The programme is taught over two years and has gained recognition and respect from the world's leading universities.

MISSION STATEMENT

The International Baccalaureate Organization aims to develop enquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.

To this end the organisation works with schools, governments and international organisations to develop challenging programmes of international education and rigorous assessment.

These programmes encourage students across the world to become active, compassionate and lifelong learners who understand that other people, with their differences, can also be right.

Since the late 1960s, the programme has:

- encouraged international-mindedness in IB students, starting with a foundation in their own language and culture
- developed a positive attitude to learning that prepares students for university education

SUBJECT OFFERINGS INDOOROOPILLY STATE HIGH SCHOOL IB PROGRAMME

Students select one subject from each group - three subjects at Standard Level (SL) and three at Higher Level (HL).

All subjects are offered at both HL and SL levels unless indicated below.

Group 1 – English A Language & Literature

Group 2 – Spanish *ab initio* SL, Spanish B HL, Mandarin *ab initio* SL, or Mandarin B HL

Group 3 – Business Management, History, or Psychology

Group 4 – Students choosing one Group 4 subject have the choice of either Biology or Physics.

Students can choose two Group 4 subjects (Biology and Chemistry, or Physics and Chemistry) in place of a Group 6 subject

Group 5 – Mathematics Analysis & Approaches HL and SL, or Mathematics Applications & Interpretation SL

Group 6 – Visual Arts, or Music

With the exception of Group 2 Languages and Mathematics, decisions on SL or HL will not be made until mid-Year 11.

COMPULSORY COMPONENTS

- Theory of Knowledge (TOK)
- Extended Essay – 4000 words, due in September of the second year
- Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS)
