- * Year 11 students are only required to be in attendance when they have a scheduled exam.
- * Accelerated/Leap Year 10 students are required to attend regular timetabled Year 10 classes during this exam block. Roll marking will be updated to reflect any lessons when these students are not present in timetabled Year 10 classes due to scheduled Year 11 exam commitments.
- * Accelerated/Leap Year 10 students should attend in the Student Centre for self-directed study where any timetabled Year 11 classes are cancelled due to the Exam Block.
- * Year 11 Leap/Acceleration students are welcome but not required to attend timetabled Year 12 classes during the Year 11 exam block. Year 11 students who choose to attend Year 12 classes around exam timetable commitments should sign in and out at Student Services for roll marking purposes.
- * IB Students do not have exams scheduled in this exam block. Regular classes will run for IB students during this exam block.
- * Students with an exam clash will be contacted by Ms Cochran (Head of Year 11) to make alternative arrangements.
- * Alternative seating exams (AARA) will be held in WO3/GO7. Students and parents are sent email communication with information about AARA provisions the week prior to exams.
- * Students who usually attend TAFE or other external providers on a day an exam is scheduled must attend their timetabled exam. The student is responsible for communicating this absence to their learning provider/employer.
- * Students should access the External assessment equipment list at <https://indoorooshs.eq.edu.au/curriculum/exam-timetables> to identify approved equipment for all assessments. Where specialised equipment is required (e.g. coloured pencils, calculators) this will be communicated by classroom teachers.
- * Students should bring stationery and other equipment in a clear plastic case / container. Equipment (including calculators) will be checked upon entry to the examination venue.

- * Students should bring their student identification card to each exam and place it on their desk. This assists with roll marking and minimising disruptions to students during exams.
