Dear parents and carers,

I am writing to inform you that Indooroopilly State High School will be open to provide supervision only tomorrow, Tuesday 11 March. This will be available for any of our students who may require it. However, with the effects of Ex-Tropical Cyclone Alfred being felt across our community, many of our staff and their families have also been affected by this event. As a result, supervision will be limited. We encourage you to consider your family's safety and circumstances when deciding if your child will attend school tomorrow.

Safety assessments

All required safety and risk assessments have been conducted and I can confirm it is safe for students and staff to attend our school in a supervisory capacity.

Student absences

Please be mindful that some of our local roads and access to our school may be affected. If this weather event poses a danger to your child travelling to school, please notify the school of your child's absence as soon as possible. Absences due to emergencies and natural disasters will not be recorded on a student's report card.

Transport services

If your child catches a bus or train to school, please check with your local transport service provider to confirm if their services will be operational tomorrow.
