DEFINITIONS

TRAINEESHIPS

A traineeship is on-the-job training with an employer, while you study and get paid - with a focus on hands-on practical learning over academic theory. It is perfect if you want to get a professional, industry-led qualification at the same time as real-world work experience. School-Based Traineeships (SBTs) are a great way to get a head start on your career by combining paid on-the-job training that leads to a qualification while completing your studies at school.

A traineeship is generally where you will achieve a Certificate I-IV in 1-2 years full-time through a registered training organisation (RTO), such as TAFE QLD.

In addition to completing qualification and unit requirements, students must complete a minimum of 80 Hours of Work Placement within the Plumbing Industry.

NOTE: Vocational Placement will require extensive time commitment.
