## An open letter to the Indooroopilly State High School Community

Dear Current and Former Indro High Students, Alumni, Staff, Parents and Community,

### Would you come back for UN Day?

Since the early 1990's, United Nations (UN) Day has been a cherished tradition at Indooroopilly State High School. We are one school, but we are united by many cultures. Over the decades, UN Day has united us and connected generations of students and staff to our remarkable school. UN Day always showcases Indro at its finest, and it forms a major part of the way our school celebrates our community's diversity.

In 2026, UN Day will be held on **Friday, 19 June** (Term 2, Week 9). From 9:00am - 3:00pm on this day, UN Day will run in its usual format as a 'closed' school-only event for current students and staff. Longstanding traditions will remain at the heart of the day, including Year 7 cultural rotations, global citizenship lessons, the Opening Ceremony and flag parade, cultural activities, performances and food stalls and the UN Day student concert.

The Parent and Citizens' Association has expressed interest in supporting the event. As part of this, UN Day will extend into a festival style community/alumni celebration on the cricket oval at the close of the school day from 3:00pm – 8:00pm. Parents, carers, alumni and the broader Indro community will be invited to participate in cultural activities, enjoy the food trucks, and watch cultural performances and the Battle of the Bands. The evening will conclude with a special finale by acclaimed musician and Indro Alumni **Clea**.

Our school has a strong and vibrant culture, and nowhere is this more evident than on UN Day. We hope this format will keep the spirit of UN Day as a school only event for current students from 9:00am – 3:00pm, while also giving former students and the wider community a chance to taste or come back for UN Day. We are not yet sure if this format is one that will continue for future UN Days, but we are keen to have a go at a slightly different format for UN Day 2026 with a greater reach.

If you are Indro Alumni from the 1990's onwards, why not come back for UN Day this year? Bring a few classmates to catch up and re-experience UN Day one more time. Some of your teachers will be there. We also know there are pockets of earlier Indro Alumni out there who meet up from time to time and hold class reunions. We reconnected with many of you at the 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary in 2024. Why not reconnect with us again this year, this time to experience your first UN Day? We'd love to welcome you back again.
