The **Year 10 Trade Taster Program** delivers training to small groups of 14 students, one day per week for seven weeks. Throughout the program, students get to try three different trade areas as well as having the opportunity to complete their <u>Construction Industry Safety White Card</u>.


Students will complete individual competencies from various programs but <u>will not</u> complete a full certificate or obtain any QCE credits.

Students will be required to commit to completion of the full program (with the exception of the Construction Safety White Card, if they already have one). Students that fail to attend all components, without evidence of a medical condition or confirmation from school of a school event that cannot be rescheduled, may be at risk of not being offered a place in future TAFE at School Programs.

#### What sort of trades are on offer?

Each of our training centres offer different trades. Each group will be a set mix of three trades. Students <u>will not</u> be able to pick and choose their trades but will undertake all trades that are in their assigned group.
