<p>Students choosing the CCNA course will study online and in practical laboratories during the four semesters of the course.</p> <p>The cost of the course is payable in advance at the start of each semester. This covers the cost of providing the laboratory equipment used exclusively by CISCO students.</p> <p>At the end of the course, to obtain the CCNA certification, students need to sit an external examination at an approved testing centre. A discount is available to students who achieve a high percentage in their school based final examinations.</p> <p>There is no set textbook for the CCNA course. All course content is online, and can be accessed by students from any workstation at the school and via the Internet at home.</p>		\$225.00 per semester
