The Scholarship provides support at four levels of representation; regional, state, national and international. The following criteria apply for successful application.

- The application must be submitted on official application form and forwarded to the Indooroopilly State High School P&C Association within two weeks of completion of event. This will then be presented at the next meeting, and notification of the success of the application will follow.
- All financial commitments to the school must have been fulfilled.
- Only one scholarship for assistance will be granted each calendar year.
- The applicant must be able to demonstrate support from the school through endorsement by school administration.
- The applicant must have gained selection to represent the school through an official selection process.
- A report will be submitted to the P&C, outlining event results/outcomes etc, which will be published in the school Newsletter.

Where there is a *high number of* applications for scholarships such that the total to be disbursed would exceed the amount budgeted by the P&C, distribution of funds will be made proportionally, based on the level of representation as follows:

- The applicant must have gained selection to represent the school through an official selection process.
- A report will be submitted to the P&C, outlining event results/outcomes etc, which will be published
 in the school Newsletter.

Where there is a high number of applications for scholarships such that the total to be disbursed would exceed the amounts budgeted by the P&C, distribution of funds will be made proportionally, based on the level of representation as follows:

Should the application for support be successful, the following financial amounts apply:

Regional	1	\$50
State in SE Qld	3	\$150
State outside SE Qld	5	\$250
National in SE Qld	6	\$300
National outside SE Qld	10	\$500

Calculation of the proportional value of 1 unit will be through dividing the total amount available by the number of units. The total available budget will be determined by the P&C each year.

EXAMPLE:

 20 Regional applications
 $20 \times 1 = 20 = \$1000$

 20 State (SE Qld)
 $20 \times 3 = 60 = \$3000$

 10 State outside SE Qld
 $10 \times 5 = 50 = \$3000$

 2 National outside SE Qld
 $2 \times 10 = 20 = \$1000$

TOTAL = 150 units TOTAL = \$8000 Available funds is \$6000, divided by 150= \$40/ unit.

So the value of a regional scholarship would be \$40; State SE Qld \$120...etc.
