

It is offered at Indooroopilly State High School as part of our commitment to developing a global perspective through the promotion of language learning.

The program runs for three years and provides students with the opportunity to accelerate their proficiency in Mandarin Chinese.

Discover Chinese Culture: China has a long and rich history encompassing many aspects of literature, art, architecture, music, and philosophy. Its influence has gone beyond China to other parts of the world, such as Japan, Korea, Vietnam and Malaysia.
