Commencing in Term 3, week commencing 5 July 2024 each taster is delivered over 10 weeks.

The units of competency provide a realistic and practical introduction to the overarching entry-level qualification. Students will gain practical skills in the relevant study area with successfully completed units eligible for credit transfer should they go on to study the full qualification.

- Successful completion of a skills taster does not result in the award of a full qualification, however some tasters may earn QCE credits. Please contact the TAFE at School team for further information.
- Students will be required to successfully complete the assessments to obtain a competent outcome for the identified units.
- For VETiS funding* eligible students, tuition fees are covered under the funding arrangements.
